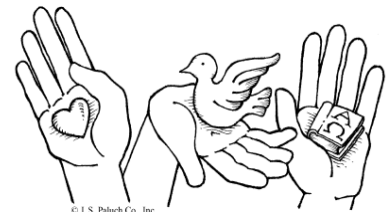


When people are present in prayer at the abortion site, through the Grace of God, hearts are changed and lives are saved.
