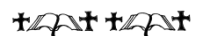

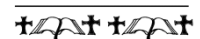

The Shepherd Speaks

When I was going to Holy Family Catholic School, Sr. Boniface used to call me her favorite saint. I thought it was in jest. But Sister was serious for she explained to me that a saint is just someone who tries to lead a good life, and when the going gets tough, they remain faithful to God. I took it seriously, and started seeing things differently. I saw that I can make choices that lead to the good and other choices that lead the other way.

I recently was given a book by a friend. The title is "The Shepherd Who Didn't Run" and it is a biography of an ordinary kid growing up in rural Oklahoma, who makes the decision to answer the Lord's Call to Priesthood. FR. STANLEY ROTHER always dreamed of being a missionary, so when his diocese established a mission in Guatemala, he chose to head it up. He fell in love with the native Indian tribes, and they fell in love with him. The ruling government and the opposing guerillas both disliked Fr. Rother, who always sided with his people. He was assassinated during the celebration of the Mass. When canonized a saint of the Church, he will be the first North American Martyr.

Just an ordinary little kid from rural Oklahoma who grew in faithfulness to the Lord. Sainthood is so very possible for us all!
