Clergy Corner

Can you believe it is Lent already? Wasn't it just Christmas yesterday, and Advent the day before? I mean, I know some people who still have their Christmas lights up. Where did the time go?

Yes it is Lent and when we think of Lent there is usually a question that comes up, "What are we **giving up** for Lent?" Ice-cream? Soft drinks? Alcohol, and so on?

May I suggest a different question this Lent, "What are we **doing** for Lent?" Traditionally, Lent is a time to put into practice three practices" Prayer, Fasting, and Almsgiving. When you think about it these 3 Lenten practices have more to do with **Doing** than **Giving Up** – more to do with **Giving** than Giving up.

Lent calls us to go beyond the giving up of some petty luxuries, or even some of our necessities. Lent has more to do with giving – giving of ourselves – emptying ourselves – for others. It is more about becoming – becoming more like Christ Jesus whom we follow. It is about finding out who God is. Finding out that God is among us (in our neighbor) and within us (in our hearts).

But how can we become more aware of this presence of God all around us and within us this Lent? May I suggest one way is to spend time doing some spiritual reading, which the Church traditionally calls Lectio Divina. Reflecting and praying over spiritual reading.

Through the efforts of the Pastoral Council, Adult Faith Formation Committee, our DRE, and our Pastor, three opportunities are available to every family in our parish. At Christmas every family received the book, "Rediscovering Jesus" by Matthew Kelly. Have you read it yet? No? Then what about reflecting and praying over this book this Lent? It has 40 very short chapters (3 pages each), one brief lesson for each day of Lent.

Our DRE and Adult Faith Formation Committee is sending a Daily Reflection Booklet home with our CCE students entitled, "Walking Together in Freedom". Extras will be available in the Vestibule. And Fr. Tim has a pocket size Daily Lenten Reflection Booklet entitled "Not by Bread Alone" for each family. All three of these have a brief scripture verse, short reflection, meditation, and a little prayer.

Why not use one of these to use around the dinner table as a family. If we are faithful to just this short prayer and reflection time, at the end of Lent we will have found God in the face of those at that dinner table, in our neighbor, and even in ourselves. My prayer is that we all have a more spiritual Lent this year by the practice of Lectio Divina.
