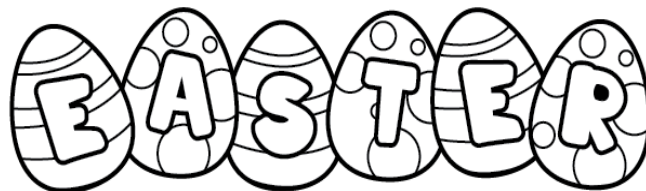

## Letter from the Food Pantry

To the Congregation of St. Peter and Paul:

It is the time of year that I would like to share everything that has been going on at the Pantry. The generous donations from your Church, and others like it, enable us to provide full bags of groceries to our clients throughout the year.

As everyone knows, Hurricane Harvey was a major event. We were not among the devastated communities so we were able to assist others who were. We cleared our shelves of every product and grocery item that we thought would help feeding the communities in need. We are so blessed at our Pantry and being able to help others in need was a blessing to us. In the aftermath, the Houston Food Bank was focused on the hard hit areas and getting food to them was a priority. We did not want to take away from that priority. We were able to continue ordering from Brookshire Bros. and the Bellville Meat Market and meet our needs. You made that possible for us.

Last month the Food Bank was alive and well and we are now able to continue our orders with them. We have been able to use an extra storage space temporarily and are stocking up on items that we use in abundance.

We have so many food drives during the holidays and that sustains us through a month. You would think it would last longer but we use an average of 10 canned items per bag, amounting to 1800-2000. This includes vegetables, soups, chili, stew, tuna, etc. So, our food drives help us through the holidays when the kids are home.

We are now in the new year and making plans. We are always thinking of the children and their holidays and summer vacations. Food drives at the end of the school year are a welcome event, providing us with an abundance of choices for kids' bags. During the summer when the kids are out of school, we try to fill our children's bags with much more.

Knowing they are home all day, we put extra items that a child can prepare. We have lunchmeat, cheese, spaghetti, mac and cheese, yogurt, lunchables, milk, etc.

We have added senior bags to our packed bags. These bags are senior friendly and provide items that are easy to prepare and enough for 1-2 seniors.

For those of you who would like to know just what it takes to receive groceries from the Pantry, here are a few facts. We require everyone to fill out an application; they need to have a current ID, showing they live in the Bellville Independent School District; they are required to list all members of the household; we receive goods from the Houston Food Bank, which receives commodities from the government, so we ask for income for the household members, and have a guideline for that information; we update our information yearly. We remain a Christian Food Pantry, though, and if for some reason the applicant cannot meet the requirement, we help them as much as we possibly can.

We continue to fill 180 family bags, 120 children's bags, 180 cold bags and another 120 children's cold bags. We provide according to the size of the family and with a variety of items for breakfast, lunch and supper such as: oatmeal, cereal, shelf stable milk, tuna, vegetables, soups, stews, chili, beans, rice, peanut butter, jelly, spaghetti and meatballs, ramen soup, cereal bars, etc. Our cold bags are filled with meats, lunchmeats, cheese, eggs, lunchables, and yogurt.

Our volunteers are a great group of people, coming from many different churches, businesses, organizations. We are a fun bunch when we are together and invite anyone who would like to participate and make a meaningful difference. We also, from time to time, have groups that want to volunteer for a day.

We sincerely thank you for thinking of us when you donate. Your generosity has enabled us to provide so much for our clients.
